GUYANA

What do you know about Guyana? Well, here are a few highlighted features and information that you may not have known.

The continent of South America is the fourth largest and fifth most populated continent in the world and dwells naturally in the southern part of the Americas. It is surrounded by the Pacific Ocean to the west and the Atlantic Ocean to the east. The continent is made up of the following 12 sovereign states: Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Ecuador, Guyana, Paraguay, Peru, Suriname, Uruguay, and Venezuela. Among these countries, Guyana stands out as the only nation on the continent where English is the official language.

Independence for Guyana was gained on Thursday, May 26, 1966 from British rule. It is the third smallest independent country in South America known as the "land of many waters", and is surrounded by the Atlantic Ocean.

The National Flower is the Victoria Amazonica, which is the largest water lily in the world, with leaves that can grow up to 8 feet in diameter.

The Flag of Guyana, often referred to as the "Golden Arrowhead," features a unique and dynamic design that symbolizes the country's rich resources and forward-looking aspirations. The flag consists of a green field with a large golden equilateral triangle extending from the hoist to the fly side. Superimposed on the golden triangle is a smaller red isosceles triangle, which also extends from the hoist side. Both triangles are bordered by narrow white and black lines, respectively. The green field represents the vast forests and agricultural lands of Guyana. The golden triangle symbolizes the country's mineral wealth, particularly its gold resources. The red triangle signifies the zeal and dynamic nature of the nation in building its future, while the black border represents the endurance and resilience of the Guyanese people. The white border symbolizes the rivers and water potential of the country. The current design of the Guyana flag was adopted on the day Guyana gained independence.



National Flower: Victoria Amazonica Lily



National Bird: Hoatzin, also known as the Canje Pheasant, is primarily found in the swamps and mangrove trees of the Amazon and can be easily spotted along the various rivers in Guyana.

National Coat of Arms includes a crest of an Amerindian head-dress symbolizing the indigenous people of the country, two diamonds at the sides of the head-dress representing mining industry, a helmet, two jaguars as supporters holding a pick axe, sugar cane, and a stalk of rice, a shield decorated with the Victoria Amazonica Lily, three blue wavy lines representing the three main rivers of Guyana, and the national bird, the Canje Pheasant. The National Motto is "One People, One Nation, One Destiny".
